Vaccination Protocol for Cats & Kittens

Core Vaccines: All kittens and cats should receive these vaccines

- Rabies: A fatal virus that is transmitted through the saliva of an infected mammal.
- Feline Distemper (FVRCP): A combination of respiratory and gastrointestinal viruses that can be fatal if not prevented.

Lifestyle Vaccine: Kittens and cats should receive this vaccine if their lifestyle indicates it.

• Feline Leukemia Virus (FeLV): A virus that weakens or destroys a cat's immune system. It is passed cat to cat through bodily fluids. Cats who go outside should always be vaccinated for this disease.

This is the recommended schedule for vaccinating your cat:

Age: 8 Weeks

• Feline Distemper: Booster this in 3-4 weeks

Age: 12 Weeks

- Feline Distemper: Booster this in 3-4 weeks.
- FeLV: Booster this in 3-4 weeks

Age: 16 Weeks

- Rabies: Booster this in 1 year
- Feline Distemper: Booter this in 1 year
- FeLV: Booster this in 1 year

Age: 16 Months

- Rabies: Booster this every 3 years for life.
- Feline Distemper: Booster this every 3 years for life.
- FeLV: Booster this every 2 years for life.
